**I/We understand and agree to the following conditions:**

- Each unit may have no more than 2 storage rack slots. Slots will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Owners will be required to renew use of their assigned slots annually.
- All equipment stored on the racks must be in working order and in active use. Racks are not to be used to store inoperable or unused equipment.
- All equipment must be identified with a waterproof tag showing the owner’s name and unit number.
- All equipment is stored on the racks at the owner’s risk. It is the owner’s responsibility to secure the equipment to the rack’s braces using cables, chains, or other means. The owner(s) indemnify the Association against loss of and/or damage to their equipment while it is stored on the racks.
- Kayaks and canoes shall only be stored in the following Common or Limited Common areas: the kayak/canoe racks, the Overflow Lot, or owner garages. Storage of these items will no longer be permitted on patios, decks, balconies or any other Common Area or Limited Common Area.
